



Twice Exceptional Students – Challenges of Identification and Support

Speaker: Huey Jy Tan

Huey Jy Tan is researching the lived experiences of primary carers of children who are gifted and have dyslexia. Often, gifted children are not catered for in Australian school settings and many remain unidentified and misunderstood. In addition, there is a subset of gifted students who are twice exceptional (2e). These students are both gifted and have a second 'exceptionality', such as autism spectrum disorders (ASD), specific learning disorders (SLD), and attention deficit hyperactivity disorder (ADHD). Jy interviewed the primary carers of gifted and dyslexic children to identify their experiences in relation to identification and educational support for their children. In this presentation, she will discuss the findings from her research to date.
