AASE RESEARCH AWARD

The AASE Research Award has been established to provide an opportunity for research which can support evidence-based practice in the education of students with additional learning needs. It is funded from contributions by AASE members – teachers, academics, therapists and others involved in the education of students with disability.

- In 2023 up to **\$15,000** is available for research that meets the AASE Research Award criteria. Research can be stand-alone or part of a joint funded project. It can be part of study leading to post graduate qualifications.
- University ethics approval must be obtained.
- The AASE Research Award is managed by AASE Executive.

REPORTING

Annual reports are required for AASE sole-funded and jointly-funded projects and a final report is required at the end of the research project. Completion of all projects will be negotiated within a 3-year period.

DISSEMINATION OF RESEARCH FINDINGS

On conclusion of the project a research paper may be offered to the Editorial Committee of the *Australasian Journal of Special and Inclusive Education* for consideration for publication.

An Executive Summary will be placed on the AASE website.

Where appropriate and relevant to the theme of the conference program, the researcher/s may be invited to present the results of the research at the annual AASE National Conference following the submission of the research report.
