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Summary







- Inclusion is facilitating belonging in diverse and identity-oriented communities, where all students can access and be challenged in any and all educational settings and be valued for who they are and what they bring
- We can *shift our thinking* towards inclusion by moving away from the assumption that the factory model of education where students are organized in homogenous one-dimensional groupings is the goal and towards the assumption that purposefully designed classrooms and schools that maintain the integrity of student diversity reflected in the community is the goal
- We can *shift our practices* towards inclusion by moving away from standardization and retrofitting for those students who don't fit and towards designing for a learning community that anticipates variability from the start and allows for student to be agents in their learning journey

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
